Quilotoa Lagoon

About 14km north of Zumbahua, the famous volcanic-crater lake of Laguna Quilotoa is a gasp-inducing sight.

A lookout on the precipitous crater rim offers stunning views of the mirror-green lake 400m below and the snowcapped peaks of Cotopaxi and Iliniza Sur.

ITINERARY

We will start early in the morning heading to the Quilotoa lagoon in the Cotopaxi Province, an old water filled caldera of volcanic origin whose water is turquoise blended color when in contact with cloud's shades.

On a nice hike down that takes about 30 minutes we could reach the bank of the lagoon. Ascending back to the top takes more time, but you have the chance to rent mules ahead or at the lagoon to do it. Back in the top we will enjoy the beautiful countryside scenery and go back to Quito.
