Chorro Waterfall & Yunguilla

Experience a day full of contrasts visiting important sites and nature in combination with stunning landscapes.

ITINERARY

Your first stop in the morning is the historical site of the battle of Tarqui (1829). From here you will be stunned at the magnificent views of the subtropical valley of Yunguilla, situated in the middle of a canyon and surrounded by rugged mountain ranges.

Next travel upwards to the base of a spectacular waterfall, known as El Chorro de Girón, 104m high and surrounded by cloud forests. Now descend into Yunguilla, a temperate farming area where sugar cane, coffee, flowers, bananas and other fruits are grown. A short distance past lush Yunguilla, you'll find it impossible to believe that you are standing in a cactus-filled desert called Jubones, where we'll take a short hike and admire the amazing scenery. Lunch is included at a local restaurant.
